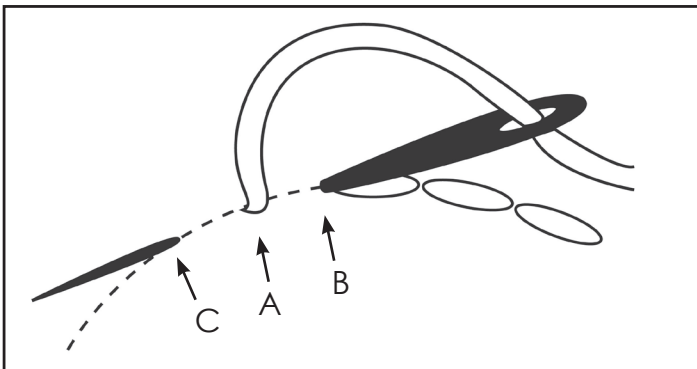




Fun Felt Embroidered Badges Make & Take

Supplies:

- Front "Crafty" or "Cute as a Button" felt piece
 - Embroidery floss
 - Large safety pin
 - Background felt piece
 - Embroidery needle
 - Thread snips
1. Cut out image inside of the printed oval. Cut out background shape.
 2. Choose your embroidery floss color and split the 6-strand floss into 2 pieces of 3 strands each.
 4. Thread your needle and pull the strands through. Tie a knot in the end of the longer tail end.
 5. Stitch over the front "Crafty" or "Cute" printed image using a back stitch (see diagram).
 4. Pick a button out of the button soup and sew button on if desired.
 5. Sew the non-pointy sharp side of safety pin to the background piece on the side with the ink. Begin and end your stitching on the side with no ink/no pin.
 6. Stitch your image piece to your background piece using matching thread and a running stitch (see diagram).

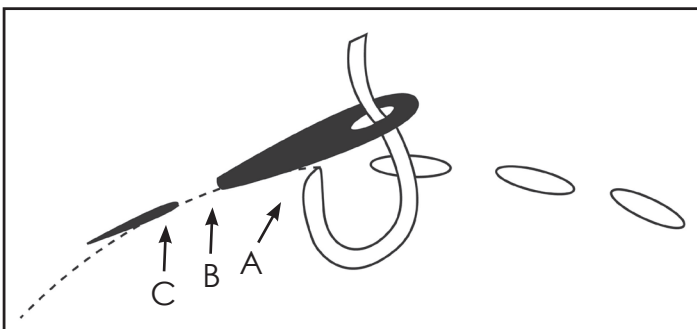


Back Stitch:

Come up at A, go down at B, then up ahead at C.

Repeat, going back into the same hole as the previous stitch.

Keep all stitches the same size.



Running Stitch:

Come up at A, go down at B, then up ahead at C.

Keep all stitch lengths and in-between spacing as consistent as possible!
